INTRODUNTION:

About Seminar:

Cell phones are becoming an important aspect of our lives. The comfort and convenience they provide certainly made our lives much easier than ever before. Two brilliant features found in modern cell phones are: the integration of digital cameras and the ability to access the Internet anytime and anywhere, thus, enabling us to seek information when we need it. Nowadays, the built-in digital camera found in cell phones and Internet access can be consolidated to provide a new dimension of information seeking. A user having a camera phone equipped with the correct reader software can scan a two-dimensional (2D) barcode and decode it to launch and redirect a phone's browser to an embedded URL or to resolve text embedded in the scanned barcode. The benefit of such a feature in modern mobile phones can be further extended to provide effective and potential library services to a new generation students. Offering mobile services has increased the physical use of the library and improves the use of reading material using a technological reference.

Knowledge Resources & Relay Centre (Central Library) is a first Library in Mumbai in Academic Domain who use QR Code technology in library services. This service starts to cater the needs of new generation students. QR Service is nothing but gives link to eContents.

KRRC had organized one day Seminar-cum "QR Code: Application in Library & Information Science" was conducted in our college on 12th March 2016.

Letter of intimation about the seminar was widely email to colleges in India through the online study circle, librarian community etc, to draw participants. The response was encouraging and total 41 participants from Mumbai, Navi Mumbai and Pune and they are from various education institutes, government organizations and corporate groups.

Why QR Service:

- ➤ Over the last two decades students have been increasingly drawn into a world of immediate, online access to information and social connections. More recently we have seen almost <u>ubiquitous mobile access to information</u>. While becoming more involved with the virtual world of information, students have become less connected to physical libraries and the information provided therein, instead preferring online access.
- ➤ QR codes offer a wide variety of useful applications for libraries, and as more and more users begin to use smart phones and other mobile devices, libraries need to find ways to reach those users.
- ➤ In order for libraries to <u>stay relevant</u>, librarians must implement the technologies that users routinely employ in their daily lives. In addition to knowing about the latest developments, we must decide which are likely to be widely adopted. Today's QR codes seem very similar and Librarians are finding uses for QR codes in their libraries.
- ➤ In our efforts to disseminate information and to engage with a generation of mobile, social and always-connected students, QR codes have tremendous potentiality. Using this technology provides an opportunity to not only facilitate library tasks but also to strength connections with this generation.

Aims and Objectives of the Seminar:

This seminar is intended to equip participants with skills to find out the resources and develop the QR Code. There will be lectures as well as intensive practical training sessions by experts in the field. Thus it will provide both theoretical base and practical skill to the participants.
