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

Subject: - Inputs from stakeholders on Syllabus/Curriculum

Dear Sir,

As per NAAC Criteria-1, Feedback on Syllabus/Curriculum has been taken from Students, Teachers, Alumni and Employers for revision & any modifications in the syllabus for academic year 2021-22. Following important points have been extracted from the feedback which shall be taken as an input for design of Syllabus in the next Revision.

A] Teachers Input

1) In Architectural Planning and Design of Buildings (Sem.III)

Following Topic needs to be added:

1. Case study on current real estate: study of typical floor plans of 1RK, 1BHK, 2BHK and 3BHK flats
2. Introduction to Building Information Modelling (BIM)

Following topics need to be omitted:

1. Built environment
 2. Manual drawing of one point perspective view
- 2) In disaster management and mitigation measures (Sem.VII), course outcomes are very general, it should be specific. This subject shall be at entry level (1st year). More applications to industry shall be included
- 3) Environment Management (Sem.VIII) subject is completely theoretical, some activities related to the course should be included in the syllabus, it will be beneficial for environment and interesting for students.
- 4) In Geotechnical Engineering-I (Sem.V) syllabus reinforced Earth should be added.
- 5) In Traffic Engineering & Management (Sem.VI) software like VISSIM shall be introduced.



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B) Employers Input

- 1) It is important for students to be knowledgeable about AutoCAD, Site Layout, BBS (steel quantity), Quantity Surveying, Auto Level Survey, Concrete Testing, and MS Excel (for billing)
- 2) Students should be oriented with respect to Industries requirements.
- 3) It is important for students to be knowledgeable about AutoCAD, Site Layout, BBS (steel quantity), Quantity Surveying, Auto Level Survey, Concrete Testing, and MS Excel (for billing)
- 4) Students should be oriented with respect to Industries requirements.

C) Alumni Input

- 1) BIM software should be introduced in theory and practical subjects.
- 2) Syllabus should give more emphasis on Practical aspect of Civil Engineering.
- 3) Every semester student should be taken to site visit for different subjects.
- 4) Should add internship into the Curriculum.
- 5) Design and Drawing softwares like Auto CAD, E-tabs, staider and Management software like MSP and Primavera P6 should be added into the Curriculum.
