Overview:

Knowledge Resources & Relay Centre (Central Library) in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of AIKTC has successfully conducted the Five Days Virtual Faculty Development Program (FDP) on "Strategies, Tools & Techniques for Researchers in the Current Scenario" on the occasion of Librarians' Day and Teachers' Day. The sessions were mainly organized on every Sunday (except Friday 20th August) from 02:00 PM to 05:00 PM (IST) from August 15th to September 5th, 2021. The FDP was conducted online on the Zoom platform and was also broadcast live on YouTube. A very good response was received by the participants from around the world. More than 250 registrations were done by faculty, researchers, & LIS professionals from all over the world. **200 participants from the scholarly community across India and 3 from other countries participated in the FDP.**

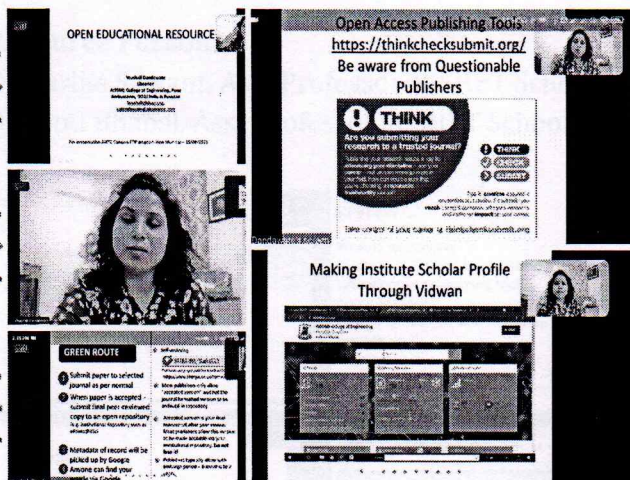
Theme of the Day1: Literature Review

Date: 15th Aug, 2022 Time: 2:00pm – 5:00pm (IST)

Ms. Shaheen Momin, Librarian from AIKTC anchored the event, followed by the recital of verses from the Quran. Resource Persons: Mrs. Vrushali Dandawate, Librarian AISSMS College of Engineering, Pune & DOAJ Ambassador of India

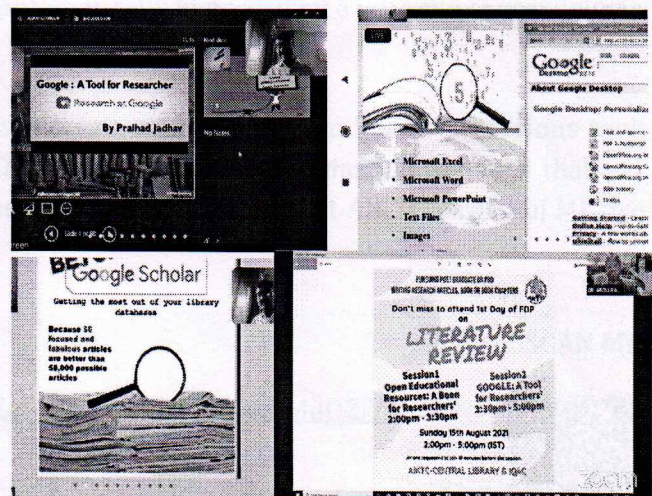


A research-based literature review requires a significant amount of data collection, which, if properly curated and managed, could be of great value to the research community and speed up related research. Mrs. Vrushali Dandawate spoke about the importance of Open Access (OA) & Science, open access publications, and the various open educational resource platforms essential for researchers to conduct literature reviews and publish their findings. She also put the spotlight on Sherpa/Romeo and the ThinkCheckSubmit site before submitting the papers to OA.

Session2: Google: A tool for Researchers'

Resource Persons: Mr. Pralhad Jadhav, Associate Director, Library Management at Khaitan & Co.

Mr. Pralhad Jadhav presented the second session, in which he discussed the various intelligent Google tools that can be used to conduct a successful literature review, including Basic Search, Advance Search, Google Scholar, Google Docs, Reverse Image, News, etc.

Date: 20th Aug, 2022

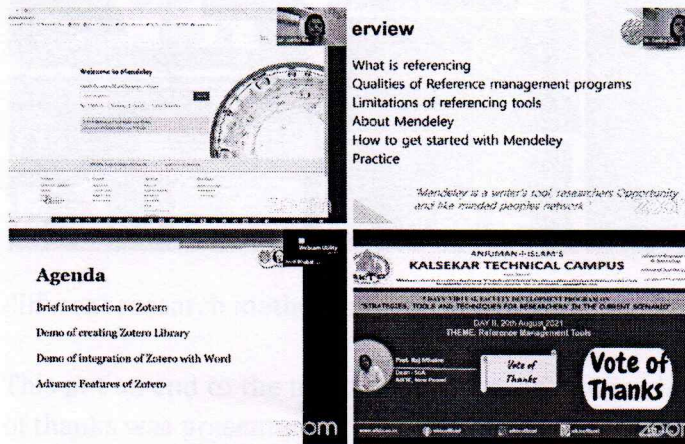

Participants discover that they can now quickly import references into Mendeley by dragging PDF files into the proper folder or by using the Web-Importer tool. Learned how to automatically sort paper collections and sync accounts across numerous computers. Using the MS Word plugin makes all their references instantly available for text citation. Within seconds, the

bibliography and citation style are organized automatically in accordance with the chosen journal style etc...

The insightful discussions came to an end as a result, and question-and-answer sessions took their place. The speakers undoubtedly provided information to the enthusiastic attendees that will help them in their future research. Date: 22nd Aug, 2022

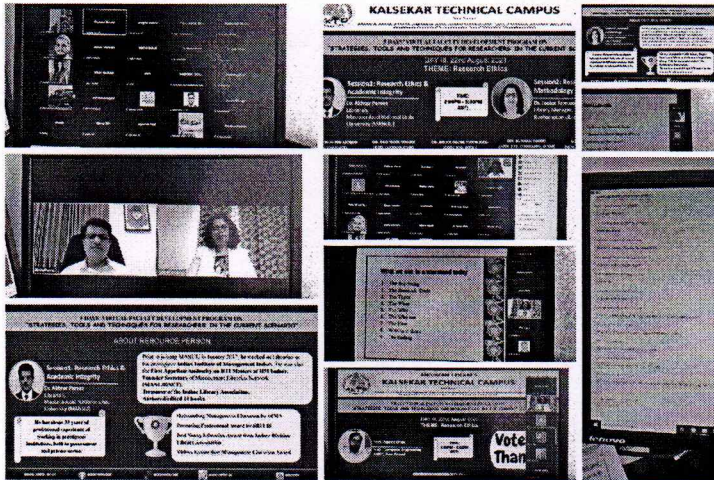

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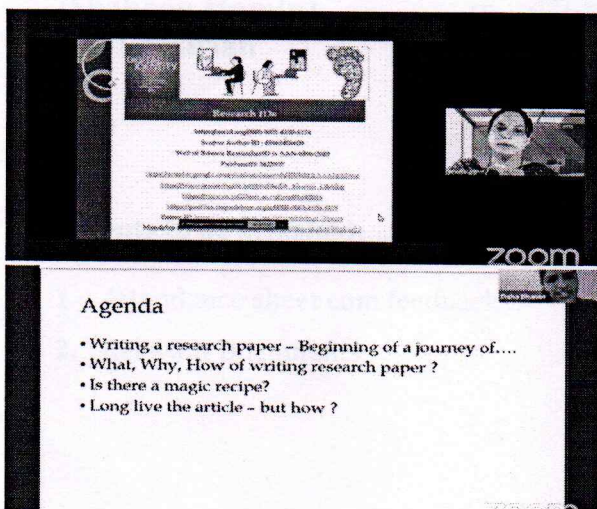


Theme of the Day5: Research Writing

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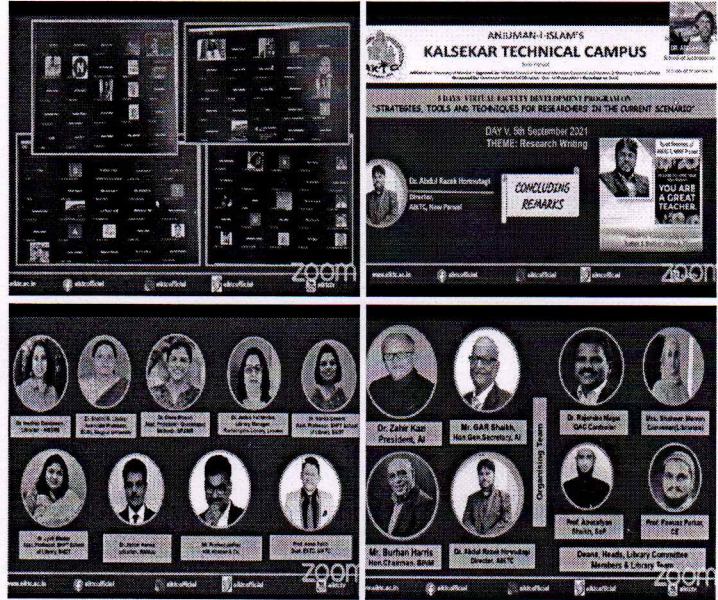
