An **Anti-Ragging Day and Week Celebration and Student Orientation Programme** was organized for all students of the B. Pharmacy programme with the objective of creating awareness about the harmful effects of ragging and promoting a safe, respectful, and disciplined academic environment.

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Vision : To be the most sought after academic, research and practice based school of Pharmacy that others would wish to emulate.



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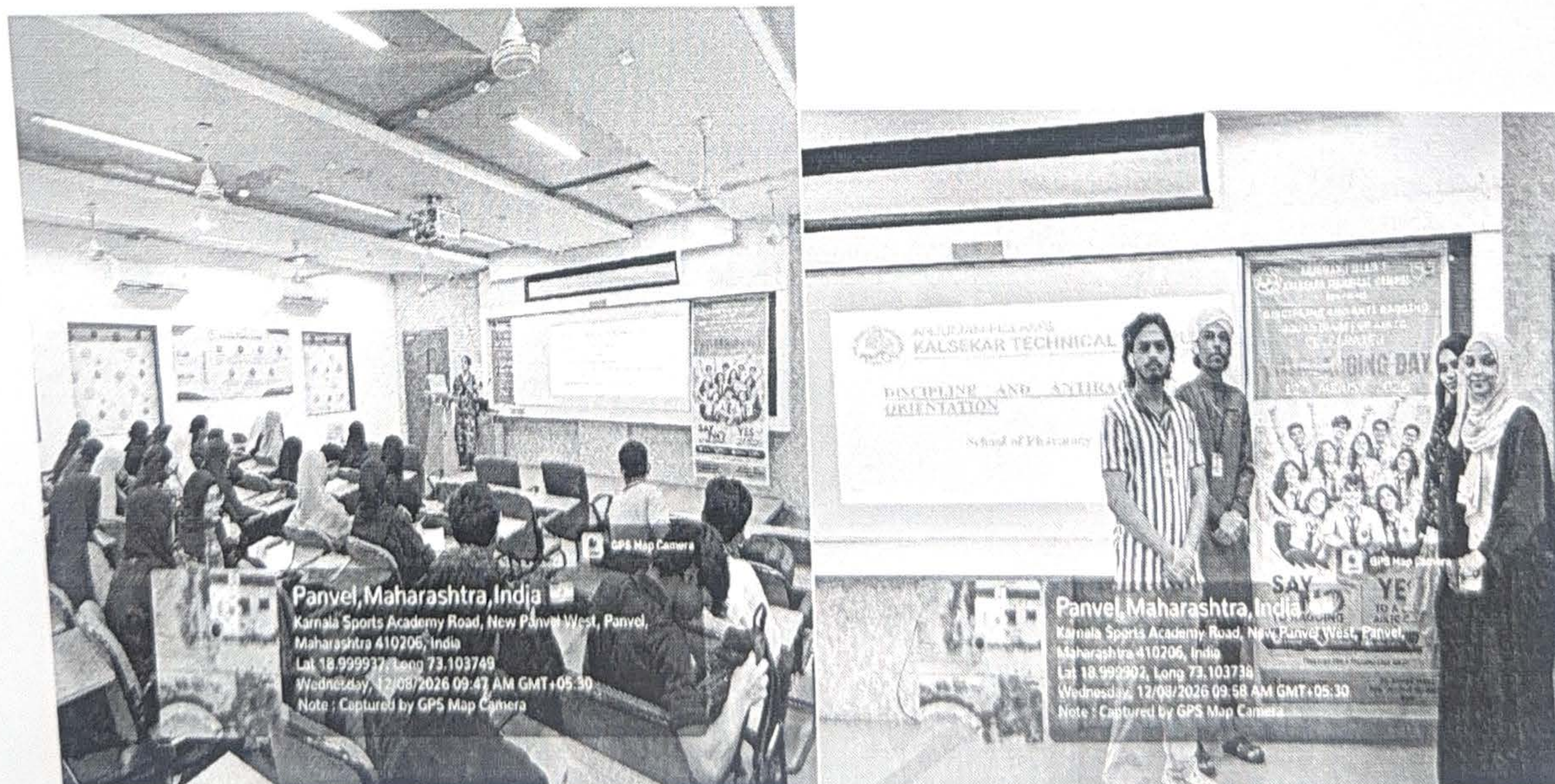
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Outcome:

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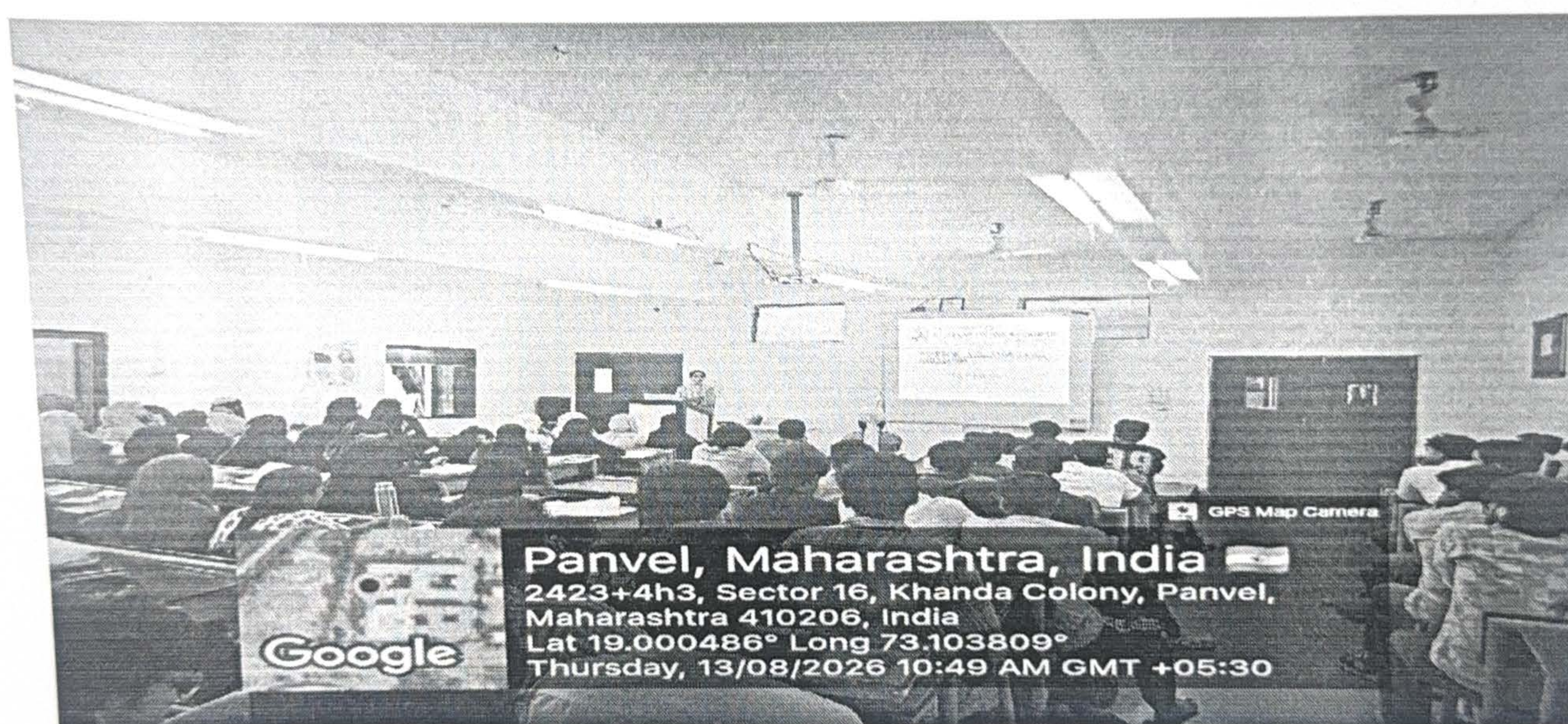
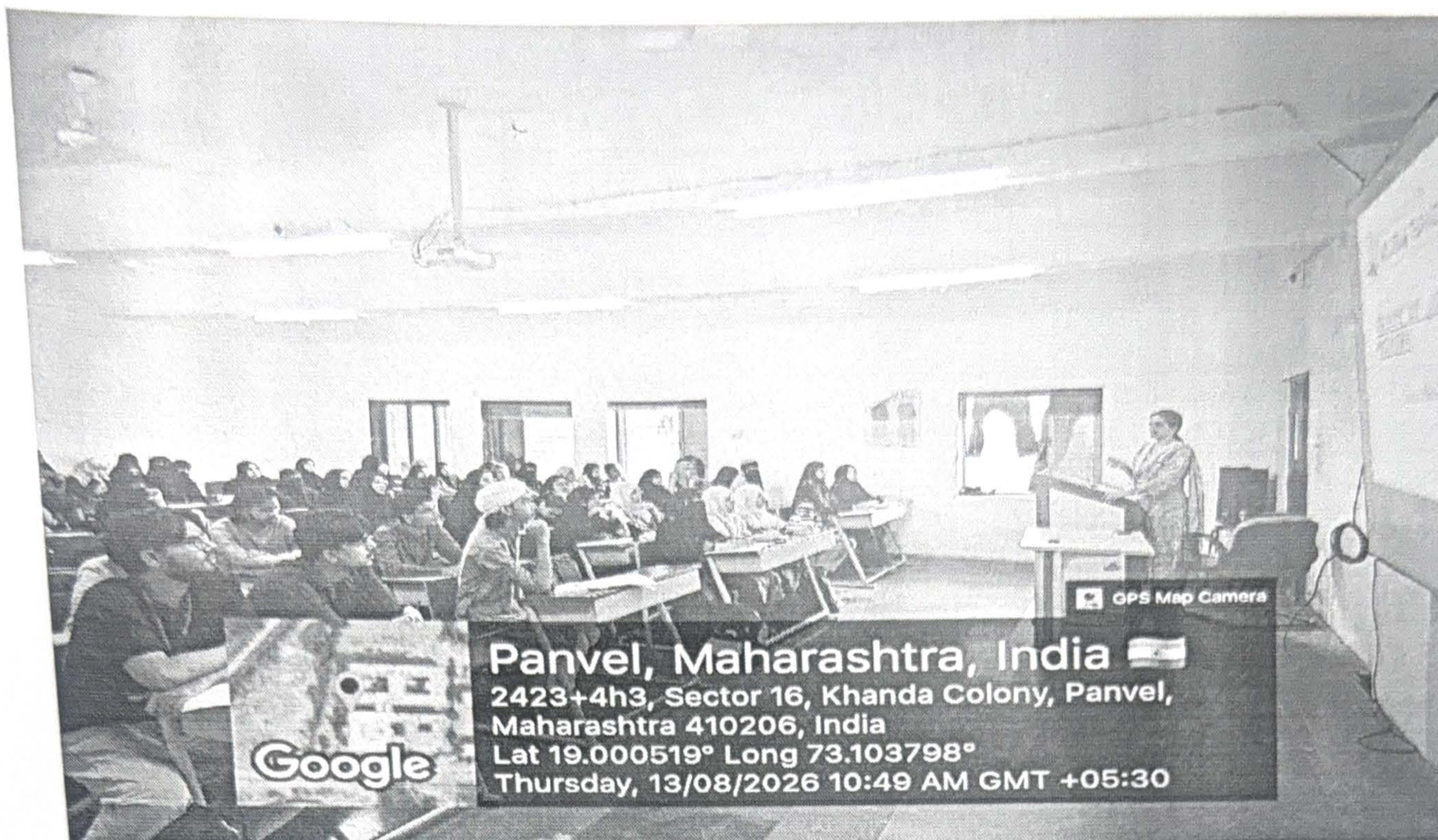
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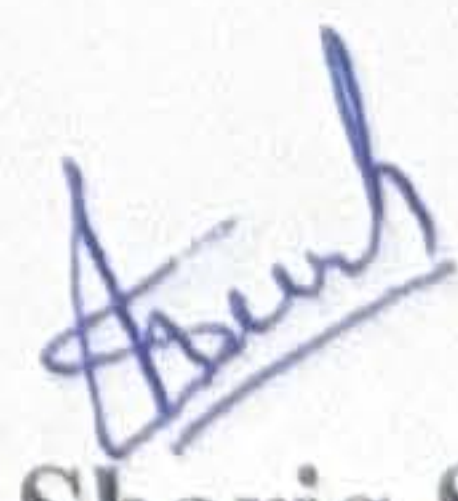
