



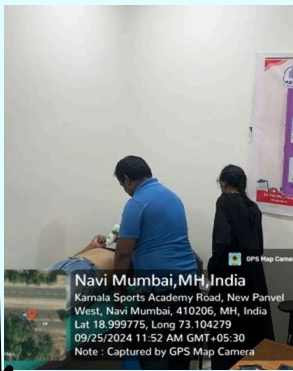

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## Newsletter World Pharmacist Day 2024 | September 25

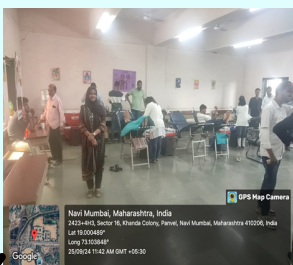
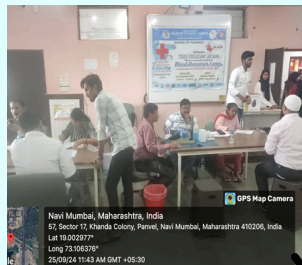


The School of Pharmacy at Kalasekar Technical Campus, Panvel, celebrated World Pharmacist Day 2024 on 25th September by hosting a Multi-Specialty Health Camp, blood donation drive, and herbal tree plantation in collaboration with industry partners. Centered on the theme Pharmacists: Meeting Global Health Needs, the event offered free healthcare services to the local community. Dr. Sanjay Gude, Assistant Superintendent of Dr. Nanasaheb Dharmadhikari Sub District Hospital, Panvel, was the Chief Guest, underscoring the important role of pharmacists in healthcare.



### ECG CAMP

An ECG camp was conducted on 25/09/2024 at AIKTC-SOP as a part of Pharmacist Day Celebration, providing free electrocardiogram screenings to the people.



### BLOOD DONATION CAMP

On the occasion of World Pharmacist Day, a blood donation camp was organized in collaboration with Red Cross society to support the community's healthcare needs. A total of 75 participants registered for the event, with 60 individuals successfully donating blood.



### MENTAL HEALTH CAMP

The Pharmacy Department's Mental Health Camp, organized in honor of Pharmacist Day on September 25, 2024, was a groundbreaking initiative. The camp aimed to raise awareness about mental health, helping individuals recognize the importance of self-care, and determining if they needed further assessment or therapy. It also served as a powerful step toward destigmatizing mental health issues and empowering individuals to prioritize their well-being.



### WOMEN HEALTH CAMP

The Woman Health Camp held at AIKTC SoP saw 71 participants, with 10 volunteers assisting. The camp aimed to raise awareness about women's health issues, providing essential screenings and consultations for various conditions like breast cancer, cervical cancer, and reproductive health.





## THYROID CAMP

The camp focused on raising awareness about thyroid disorders and offered free thyroid function tests. Participants were screened for common thyroid-related issues like hypothyroidism and hyperthyroidism.



## DIABETES CAMP

The primary goal of the camp was to raise awareness about diabetes prevention, management, and early diagnosis. Free blood sugar testing and consultations with healthcare professionals were provided.



## ASTHMA CAMP

The camp provided free lung function tests and consultations with respiratory specialists. Participants learned about asthma triggers, prevention strategies, and treatment options, including inhaler use.



## HERBAL TREE PLANTATION

The initiative aimed to promote environmental sustainability by planting herbal trees on the campus.

## NUTRITIONAL CAMP

The camp focused on promoting healthy eating habits and providing personalized dietary advice to participants. Nutritional experts offered consultations based on the individual's health needs, addressing issues like obesity, malnutrition, and dietary deficiencies.
